Suggested revision to bylaws:

EXISTING TEXT:

<u>Section 5.2 Election of Directors and Term:</u> Every election cycle, vacancies within the Board of Directors shall be filled. The current Board of Directors may appoint additional nonvoting board members for a term of one year. There shall be an election by ballot to fill the remaining positions for a term of two years. Every election cycle, the City of Bend and Bend City Council shall each appoint one representative to serve as an ex-officio director for a one-year term; DBBA shall request that Bend Metro Park and Recreation District appoint one representative to serve as an ex-officio director for a one-year term; and, a number of directors equal to that of those whose terms have expired shall be elected. At the expiration of any term, any director may be reelected or re-appointed.

PROPOSED NEW TEXT:

Section 5.2 Election of Directors and Term:

Every election cycle, vacancies within the Board of Directors shall be filled. The current Board of Directors may appoint additional nonvoting board members for a term of one year. Every election cycle, the City of Bend and Bend City Council shall each appoint one representative to serve as an ex-officio director for a one-year term; DBBA shall request that Bend Metro Park and Recreation District appoint one representative to serve as an ex-officio director for a one-year term. The term for an appointed director shall run from July of the current year through June of the following year. There shall be an election by ballot to fill the remaining positions for a term of twenty-six (26) months; a number of directors equal to that of those whose terms have expired shall be elected. The term for an elected director shall run from May of the current year through June of the following year. At the expiration of any term, any director may be re-elected or re-appointed.
