5.) Bend Oktoberfest 2022 8:35 – 8:50 a. Timeline & Options

- EID fees do not cover operating costs. Do we want Octoberfest to occur?
- Possible mirror pond south lot and Brooks Alley could be shut down. Do we want to do a hybrid Octoberfest? Barbara states funds can be community events. And quotes were still about 75k. Mindy recommends a separate account of funds for Octoberfest.
- Scott Brees of Connect Central Oregon would like to continue with the event as part
 of 100 year anniversary. And some of funds can be supported by City and Parks and
 Rec if we partner with them. There will be an event from Central district to
 downtown and we should have Octoberfest.
- Barbara says special insurance costs are expensive as an example.
- Christine and Melanie would like to be part of event committee with joint meeting on Octoberfest.
